Project West White Rose Project, Newfoundland

Project The White Rose field and satellite extensions are located in the Jeanne d'Arc Basin, 350 km east of Newfoundland and Labrador in approximately 120 m of water. The West White Rose Project will be developed through a fixed drilling platform consisting of a concrete gravity structure (CGS). The CGS Construction Contractor will be constructing the CGS in the Argentia Graving Dock, located on the Argentia Peninsula approximately 130 km from St. John's, NL. The CGS is constructed under dry conditions. After construction of the CGS is complete the Graving Dock will be flooded, and the CGS will be floated and towed out to the final installation location in the White Rose field.

In order to facilitate the tow-out of the CGS after construction, dredging will be required to clear any debris from the seabed and to reduce the existing seabed levels to the required depths.

As the Client's appointed Dredging Consultant, ADBP are employed to assist in all aspects of the dredging. ADBP have consulted on numerous studies of the ground condition during the pre-tender stage including bathymetric, geotechnical, geophysical and seismic studies. ADBP have assisted in the selection and procurement of suitable dredging service providers as well as the contract drafting for the project, subsequent tender analysis, and contract negotiations.
